Crosstab Questions

The closed-ended questions in the survey were cross-tabulated using the questions listed below. Crosstabs with significant differences are featured here. See the Excel spreadsheet for all of the crosstabs.

- Are you currently employed full-time, part-time, or not employed?
- Which of the following categories best describes the industry you work in?
- Approximately how many employees work at your organization (all locations)?
- Census Region
- How would you characterize the area you live in?
- Do you describe yourself as a man, a woman, or in some other way?
- Derived (Generation): What is your birth year?
- Derived Age Range: What is your birth year?
- What is your marital or relationship status?
- Household Size
- Children at Home
- Education Recategorized
- Race Ethnicity Variable
- Which category represents the total combined income of all members of your family during the past 12 months?
- Ideology

Crosstab Methodology

While we cross-tabulated closed-ended questions by all of the listed questions, we only report cross-tabulations with statistically significant differences that might have some practical value:

- A statistically significant difference is one that cannot be attributed to chance at a 95% confidence level: 19 times out of 20 the differences would exist in the target population.
- A practical difference, in our opinion, is at least a 10 percentage-point difference between two groups: while a 2-point difference might for large cell sizes be statistically significant it is unlikely to make any practical difference to most business plans.
- Demographic questions against demographic questions are typically ignored, as they offer little insight (e.g., older people are more likely to be retired, Gen Xers are more likely to have children than Millennials, those with college degrees have higher incomes than those without, and so on).
- Occasionally, for editorial reasons or if a cross-tabulation seems redundant, we omitted including it in this report.
- See the accompanying spreadsheet for all tables.

Rather than compare subgroups to other subgroups individually, we compare each subgroup to the aggregate of all other subgroups. This is easier to present and visualize than column comparisons (which require tagging each column with a letter) and differentiates at the low end as well as the high end. Since this approach uses the entire sample, rather than a subsample of two subgroups, it provides greater statistical power and reduces the chance that differences are false discoveries

If the difference is higher at a statistically significant level, the cell is marked with the up - arrow symbol \updownarrow . If it is lower, the down-arrow symbol \Downarrow is used. Differences you may observe between cells unmarked by arrows were not statistically significant: they exist in the survey sample but are not presumed to exist in the target population.



Which struggles have you ever faced at work with respect to name mispronunciation?



Who has mispronounced your name in the workplace?















In what circumstances has your name been mispronounced at work?



How do you feel when someone mispronounces your name in the following work situations?








































